

Prison preparation form ("Knastzettel")

Note: Depending on the region and action, there is often no stable prison support group. This form should therefore help you to prepare yourselves in your affinity groups.

WHERE to put the completed form?

The forms are sometimes (but not always!) accepted by the EA (legal team).

Otherwise: Keep it safe so that repressive authorities can't find the sensitive data, but accessible enough so that supporters can get to it in an emergency!

E.g. encrypted mail to friends, sealed envelope at the lawyer's, ...
